Despite the years of pandemic pivoting and declining funds for field trips and transportation, the Village View Dolphins—including families, faculty, administration, and staff—launched an exciting, innovative, and immersive program for students in grades TK (Transitional Kindergarten) through 5th grade to explore a global subject with local roots: **Marine Science!**

Our school's mission is to explore the National Marine Educators Association's **Ocean Literacy** curricula, which is a comprehensive interdisciplinary study of marine life, oceanography, and stewardship. Though we are very lucky to live in Surf City, USA alongside some amazing coastal ecosystems, our aim is to send our oldest students to the Catalina Island Marine Institute as a culmination of their yearlong studies and lead the way for all Dolphins to joyfully anticipate their own trip to this wondrous outdoor classroom experience.

"That's great!" you may say, "but why am I getting this letter?"

We're reaching out to our community because this ambitious program needs support in many forms: start-up funding, in-kind donations, spreading the news of our school and its goals, and sponsoring disadvantaged students so they can attend CIMI.
